TORM KANSAS ATTACKED BY PIRATES

Hellerup, 6 November 2010 – The MR vessel TORM Kansas has been under attack by pirates off Mombassa Friday evening 5 November.

We are pleased to inform that at 6:30 pm due to the professional handling of the situation by the Captain and his crew, the pirates gave up the attack. The Captain and his 21 Indian crew members are all safe and unharmed.

TORM Kansas departed from Mombassa at 0900 hrs Friday morning after discharging a cargo of approx. 36,500 mt gasoil. The vessel was thus in ballast enroute to Fujairah when the pirates attacked.
